„Fortunately, the proportion of female driving instructors has been rising steadily for years: 3.4% from 2014 to 2022. The individual German states show a very different picture with regard to the proportion and their development over time: The largest increase of 5.2% was seen in Hamburg, while Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania saw the smallest increase of 1.4% among the German states.“
