„The KBA statistics below show that the number of alcohol violations decreased by nearly 11% from 2018 to 2021. Over the same period, the number of drug violations increased by just under 14% and driving without a license despite a driving ban increased by about 10%. It is precisely the increase in drug violations is to be critically questioned in the context of the current discussion about the legalization of cannabis use.“

* Note: Multiple entries for the same facts (on one report): When analyzing, it should be noted that, for example, up to 10 violations can be specified per report stored in the Driver Fitness Register (FAER). Each of these up to 10 violations, although combined on one report, is counted on its own. The number of reported violations can therefore be greater than the number of reports in the access.
